Keys

You are provided with two keys — one for the gate and the larger one for the front door.

Golf carts may be left safely on the driveway outside the gate.

Outdoor Lights

Garden and pool lights turn on automatically each evening.

Security Cameras

Four exterior cameras monitor the outside of the home only. They are for owner property oversight.

Mosquito Screens

Please keep all screens closed to prevent insects. Mosquito repellent is available at many shops on the island.

MONEY:

We recommend exchanging USD to pesos for the best rates.

Exchange services are available at the ferry terminal and island banks. Restaurants, bars, and taxis may offer poor exchange rates if paying in USD.

Safes

Each bedroom has a safe with a key for easy locking and unlocking.

Security Deposit

Your rental includes a \$500 security deposit.

Please avoid sitting on the sofa or bar stools while wet or while wearing sunscreen or tanning oils, as these surfaces stain easily.

Air Conditioning

Each room has its own split-unit AC.

-Recommended temp: 24°C

-Do not set below 20°C

-Keep bedroom doors closed

-Do not run AC with doors/windows open

High humidity and salt air can damage the units if overworked.

3 - The House

Kitchen

The kitchen includes:

Toaster, Keurig coffee maker, blender, kettle, microwave, and oven.

Drinking water is provided via bottled water in the refrigerator and the kitchen dispenser.

Tap water is not safe to drink.

Trash Pickup:

Place trash by the bushes at the end of the driveway.

Collection: daily from 3:00–5:00 PM.

Dishwasher

A dishwasher is available for your use.

Bathrooms

Island water pressure is low.

Hot water may take 1–2 minutes to reach the showers.

To fully flush the toilets, hold the flush button down until all water has been released.

Utilities (Island-Wide Notes)

Water

The island's water supply comes from Cancun. Occasional outages may occur — these are outside our control.

Electricity

Power interruptions can happen (planned or unplanned).

We will notify you if the outage is scheduled.

If an issue seems specific to Casa Luz, please contact the property manager — local plumbers and electricians can be sent quickly.

IN A WATER OUTAGE:

Pool water may be used to refill toilet tanks temporarily.

Laundry

Washer and dryer are located outside on the left side of the house behind metal doors.



Pool & Garden

The pool pump runs on a timer.

Our gardener maintains the pool chemistry and garden and may enter through the gate, but will not disturb your stay.

Pool tiles can be slippery when wet — please use caution.

Beach towels are provided in each closet.

4 - Getting Around & TV

Taxis

Taxis pass by the house frequently.

To hail one, simply stand on the sidewalk and raise your hand.

Tip:

Negotiate the fare before entering to avoid surprises.

If you need a scheduled pickup, we can arrange one for you.



Television / Streaming

Each TV has a Firestick installed with access to:

- 1,500+ live channels (US, UK, Canadian markets)
- Sports channels
- Streaming series
- 1,000+ movies

How to Use

- 1) Turn on TV with the Firestick remote.
- 2) Press the Home button.
- 3) Go to Apps → open Infiniti.
- 4) Channels may take a moment to load.
